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## Hangar Inspection Checklist Instructions

The County of Ventura, Department of airports may have access to the hangar, with reasonable notice provide for non-emergency access, for any lawful purpose, including, but not limited to, inspections, making necessary improvements, and annual inspection of Lessee's fire extinguisher, and to confirm compliance with the terms of the lease.

The checklist is to be completed by Department of Airport staff:

- Section A <u>Type of Inspection:</u> In this section you select the appropriate inspection type. If "Other" write down what type of inspection it is.
- Section B <u>Tenant Information</u>: In this section you will take down the information of the tenant for the hangar being inspected.
- Section C <u>Aircraft Inventory at Time of Inspection:</u> In this section you will document all aircraft in the hangar at the time of the inspection.
- Section D <u>Maintenance Inspection Checklist:</u> In this section you will be looking for anything that would require maintenance that is the tenant responsibility and the maintenance of the grounds that is the Department of Airport responsibility.
- Section E Permitted Use Inspection Checklist: In this section you are looking for the overall use of the hangar and that complies with the lease.
- Section F <u>Safety Inspection Checklist:</u> In this section you are looking for any safety related issues inside or outside the hangar. Any issues please put them in the out of compliance box.
- Section G <u>Tenant Signature:</u> The tenant will have to sign the inspection that they agree to the findings, needed correction(s), and they agree to the pictures taken.
- Section H <u>Department of Airports Use Only:</u> In this section you will note date of inspection, and any discrepancies or issues found during the hangar inspection.
