FINANCIALS AT A GLANCE

The Airport Enterprise Fund (Camarillo and Oxnard Airports)

- Self sufficient operation that generates more than \$9,000,000 annually in revenues with <u>zero</u> County General Fund or other local tax revenues needed to support the airport system
- The 5-Year AVERAGE for the Airport Enterprise Fund
 - Operating SURPLUS of \$2,500,000 (without deprecation)
 - 2. Reserve BALANCE of \$17,600,000

Completed \$14 million reconstruction and pavement replacement of entire Runway at Oxnard Airport

Completed new leases with 220 private hangar tenants

Initiated new Fly Friendly VC aircraft noise mitigation program

Entered into partnership agreement with University of Alaska Fairbanks (Pan-Pacific UAS Test Range)

Completion of \$40 million executive hangar facility at Camarillo Airport

Selected two companies to develop 5-acre and 7-acre parcels at Oxnard Airport

Kicked off FAR Part 150 Noise Studies at both Camarillo and Oxnard 7 Airports

Sustainable Cash Flow

Approximate Net Operating Income \$219.6K

Increase in total revenue \$295.6K (3.4%)

- Higher tenant occupancy in Camarillo Business Park
- Favorable interest rates on investment revenue

- Camarillo Business Park improvements

- Other Airports maintenance costs as needed

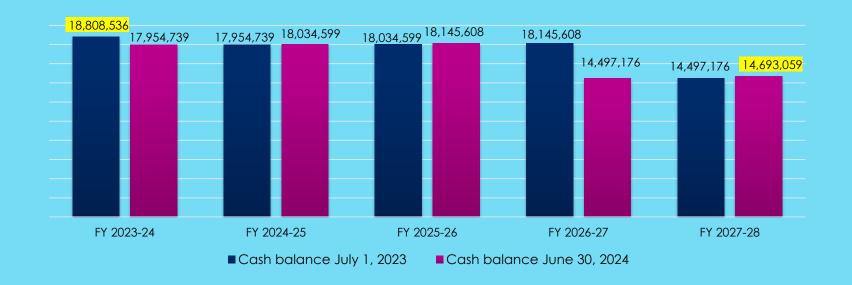
BUDGET HIGHLIGHT S

Labor expense increase \$422.8K (10%)

 An increase in salaries & benefits due to the addition of a Deputy Director, Facility Project Specialist and Administrative Assistant IV

Calculated depreciation expense down by \$143.6K (7.8%)

Projected Cash Balance of \$17.9M at year end compared to \$18.8M at the prior year end

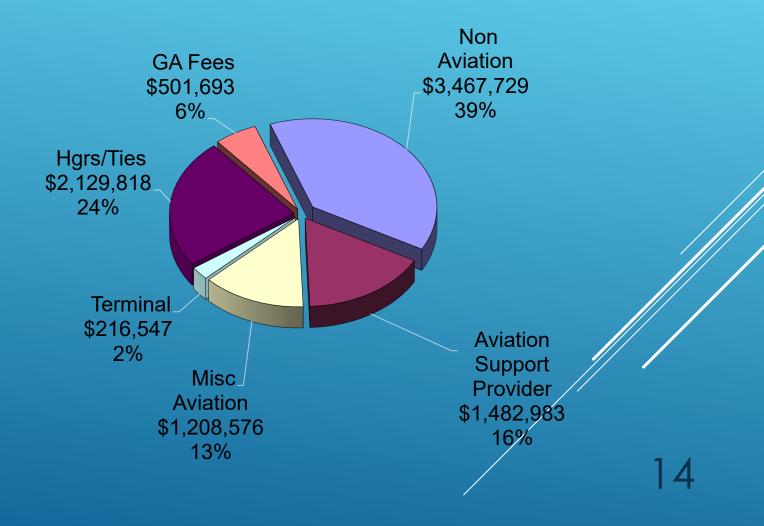

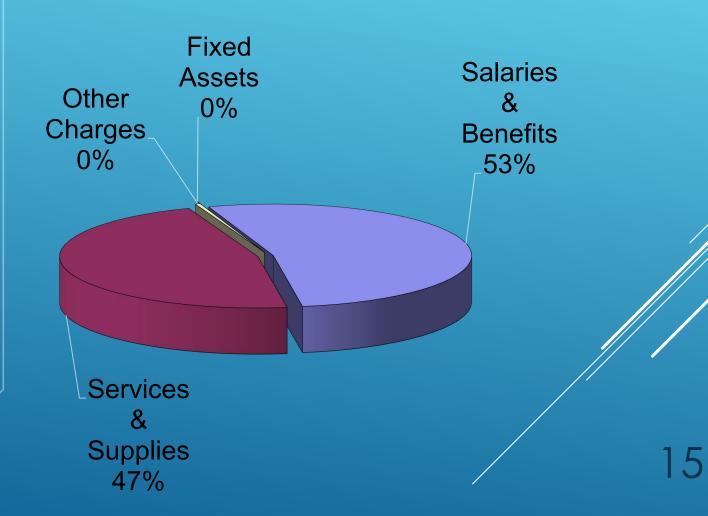
COMBINED REVENUES BY SOURCE

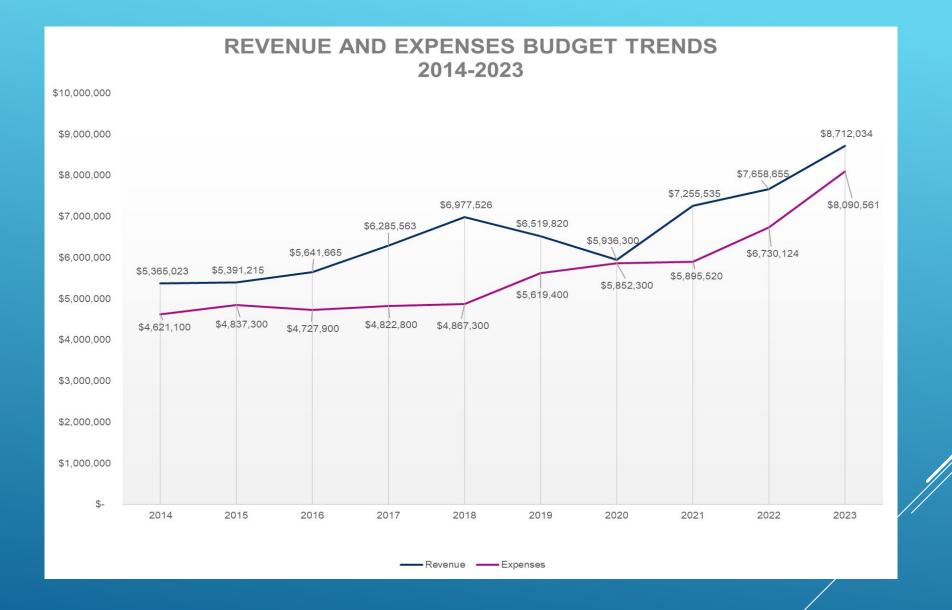
